## *Vocation Call* — *This story comes from Bishop Glen John Provost, Bishop of Lake Charles, Louisiana, 5/11/14*

“I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly” John 10:10

A lovely story is told about Pope St. Pius X who was a very humble man and had a saintly mother, Margarita Sanson. Because they were so poor, she worked at washing laundry and school maintenance to earn enough money so that he could go to the seminary. In those days, the family was completely responsible for seminary education. When he became bishop, his mother was present, and as customary, she kissed his prominent ring. She then presented her tiny hand with her wedding ring and said, “Now you kiss my ring—for without it, you never would have received yours!” Pope St. Pius X later said, “Every vocation to the priesthood comes from the heart of God, but it passes through the heart of a mother.”

Mothers and vocations are vitally linked. This we can never forget. I think every priest can relate to this truth. Priestly vocations are very much planted and nourished by motherly devotion, prayer, self-sacrifice and example. They help create what Pope St. John Paul II called and “environment for vocation.”
