During the lead-up to the 2021 Summer Social/Picnic the thought was put forward that we have the Summer Social as a family event. That is, that it includes not just we parents and grandparents, but also include our priest sons' siblings and nieces and nephews. I expect such a gathering might entice several our priest sons to attend, also. What are your thoughts? Let me or one of the officers know what you think of the idea.

Heart of the Shepherd

While many parishes have completed their participation in the solicitation phase of the campaign, there are still a number of parishes yet to participate in the effort. Nonetheless, based on early results of the campaign, work is progressing on the goals of the campaign. Most visible is the complete renovation of the seminarians' living quarters. The wing that previously housed the St. Mary seminarians is nearly complete. It is anticipated to be ready for the Borromeo seminarians by Thanksgiving. At that time, all seminarians and faculty will be moved out of the Borromeo wing so that wing can be renovated for St. Mary's seminarians. The St. Mary seminarians temporarily will be housed in neighboring parishes or in their internship or diaconate parishes. If your parish has yet to solicit for the Heart of the Shepherd campaign, please speak up in support of it.

Did you know?

That it was Pope St. Alexander (105-115 AD) who approved the addition of water to the wine in the sacrifice of the Mass as well as the introduction of holy water.

That it was Pope St. Pius I (140-155) who established Christian Easter to be the first Sunday after the first full moon after the vernal equinox in March.

That Pope St. Gregory I, the Great (590-604), during a great plague in Rome, urged people to respond "God bless you" to a person's sneeze or cough. He was urging the people to pray all the time during the plague and encouraged people to use that as a frequent prayer against the causes of the plague.

The Nicene Creed was written at the First Ecumenical Council of the Catholic Church in 325 AD in the city of Nicaea (present day Iznik, Turkey). It was amended at the Second Ecumenical Council in 381 AD in the city of Constantinople (modern day Istanbul, Turkey). Today we use the amended form.

Minutes of the Governing Board Meeting - - - July 25, 2021

- This gathering of the Parents of Priests began with the 11:00 Mass at St. Hilary Parish. The pastor, Father Steve Brunovsky, was the celebrant.
- Following Mass there was a picnic in the outdoor pavilion at St. Hilary. The meal was catered by City Barbecue in Fairlawn, OH. There were 26 members in attendance. Both Father Steve and Father Cameron joined us for the picnic as well as two guests.
- Prior to the picnic lunch, Lou Trenta held a short meeting using the printed agenda as a guide.
- The minutes of the April 11, 2021 meeting were approved and the new members, Robert and Jane Popik, were welcomed. Their son, Father Cameron, was ordained in May and is assigned to St. Hilary.
- Micki Trenta, Secretary, went over the handouts which included the minutes, communication updates, upcoming dates, and information about the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly.
- Lou continued the meeting with updates from the following committees:
 - ✓ “25 Club” – ticket packets were given to members present; other will be mailed on Monday. Ticket sales are encouraged by all members. Last year was a good year with returns that supported the seminarians.
 - ✓ The annual update/handout for the Deceased Priests and Parents of Priests was distributed. This is prepared for us by Laura Retar and printed by Mary Avenoso in the Vocation Office.
 - ✓ Lou requested that volunteers come forward to help with the Program Committee and “25 Club Committees”.
 - ✓ Laura has resigned her position which tracked the deceased priests and parents of priests, and that information will now be handled by the Secretary.
 - ✓ Mary Anne Trask has resigned her responsibility for the newsletter. That will now be handled by the President.
 - ✓ Don Trask, assisted by Mary Anne Trask, will continue to handle the memorial gifts as well as the birthday gifts for the seminarians.
- The Treasurer, Ed Suszynski, gave an update on the finances. All the transactions for the 2020-2021 fiscal year were reviewed and verified. No printed report was distributed.
 - ✓ The Treasurer was requested to supply the income data from the previous three fiscal years for IRS purposes.
- The Bylaws Revision was presented. As required in the bylaws, members were sent a mailed copy of the proposed bylaw changes which will be voted on at the next Parents of Priests meeting.
- There was no unfinished business to handle. There was also no new business to discuss.
- The meeting closed with the Prayer for Priest Sons and the food blessing. The picnic and visiting took place following the meeting.
