From the President

Happy and Blessed New Year

There are at least three "new years" at play in the life of the parents of priests. First, and most significant, is the date of ordination for our sons, the priests of the Diocese. That date marked their and our entrance into a new state of life: They as ordained ministers to God's people, and we as parents-supporters of those ministers and of each other in our new life-states.

Second is the fiscal new year when we close one year's financial support of those discerning for the priesthood and open a new year's support efforts. We are supporting our sons by encouraging those who would join them in their ministry.

Third is our monetary membership year which begins with each new calendar year. While all parents of priests in the Diocese are members for life once their sons are ordained, it takes money to give life and presence to our organization, Parents of Priests of the Diocese of Cleveland, Inc. While the 25 Club raises significant dollars, all that money, after expenses, is given to the seminarians. The operational expenses for the Parents of Priests organization comes from member dues payments and donations. If dues payments and donations exceed the operational costs for our organization each year, the funds are added to the 25 Club monies and given to the seminaries.

This year's registration and dues form is included with this Newsletter/Update. The dues are used for our non-25 Club expenses.

Please use the registration form even if you chose not to pay the annual dues. The registration form enables the officers to have up-

to-date contact information for our members. We particularly seek up-to-date email addresses so that we can save the cost of printing and mailing.

Beyond the Dues

There are many ways to support our organization and through it to support our priest sons. The most important is prayer: Prayer directly for our sons, prayer for our families as supporters of our sons, and prayers for the seminarians who are discerning if their vocation is to the priesthood with our sons. We provide a four-month prayer calendar three times a year. It lists days of prayer for individual seminarians.

Another significant way to support ourselves and each other and us is to participate in the work of one of the Parents of Priests committees. Current members of each committee and their contact information are provided later in this Newsletter.

The Liturgy Committee arranges for the Quarterly Masses. They contact pastors, get calendar dates, welcome members to the host parish, and arrange for a brief "coffee and donuts" social time after the Masses.

The Program Committee, in communication with the Liturgy Committee, selects dates and locations for the Winter and Summer Socials. It arranges for catering for the meal and any set up and clean up. Currently Mike Cubera is doing this in addition to his work as Treasurer. We really need some help here.

The Membership Committee works to initiate parents of newly ordained priest into the Parents of Priests. The members contact the parents very soon after their son's ordination and

provide them with information about our organization and the Parents of Priest pin. During the first year after their sons' ordinations, the Committee contacts the parents to remind them of and invite them to participate in each of our activities.

The 25 Club Committee is responsible for preparing the materials and distributing the solicitations for people to participate in the 25 Club fund raiser each year. It involves editing and revising the various documents, getting them printed, collating them, and getting them distributed. The editing, printing, and collating take place in the spring; the distribution takes place primarily in the summer. The Diocesan Vocation Office handles the registration of participants, and the Treasurer handles the money, depositing income and paying out winners. We need a chairperson and a committee member for most of the work (May through June); volunteers are asked to assist with the collation of the materials in late June or early July.

The Ways and Means Committee works in an advisory capacity with the Treasurer to ensure that our financial dealing and reports comply with standard accounting procedures for non-profit organizations and any applicable laws.

The Deceased and III Parents of Priests

"get well" wishes to those who are ill. Members who wish to be listed in the weekly prayer lists need to contact the Micki Trenta, our Secretary, weekly with that request. The Secretary has taken over these duties since she gets the information from the DVO as it is published.

Governing Board

All members of the Parents of Priests are eligible to participate on the Governing Board. Those who attend the meetings make the guiding decisions for the Parents of Priests. This Board is responsible to authorize and oversee all the activities of the Parents of Priests of the Diocese of Cleveland, Inc. It determines the source and the disposition of our funds. The next regular meeting is **Sunday, April 23, 2023, 2:00 PM** at the Center for Pastoral Leadership.

POP Textbook Fund & Dad's Wallet Funds

As noted in the last Newsletter and Update, the bulk of the Parents of Priests' donations is going into these funds. What we are providing certainly does not remove these costs from the seminarians; it only ameliorates them. It is estimated that the textbook costs for all the seminarians adds up to over \$20,000 per year. Any additional donations would be welcomed. You can make the checks payable to one of the seminaries or to the CPL citing its purpose on the "For" line on your checks. For Dad's Wallet it should specify which seminary's fund it is for.

Here is the POP Financial Report as of December 28, 2022.

President's Acct: Balance is \$1,412.61. This amount includes the \$500.00 transferred to it today from the Treasurer's Acct. [There are \$395.63 in uncashed checks outstanding. Lou]

Treasurer's Acct: Checkbook Balance is \$13,377.17. We still have \$4,090.00 in expenses to pay in 2023. The 2023 expenses yet to be paid are:

- \$800.00 for Seminarian birthday gifts
- \$3,090.00 for the remaining 25 Club Payouts.
 Subtracting these committed expenses
 leave us with a working balance of \$9,287.17 for
 the remainder of our fiscal year.
